- 1959 – Plant opened under the name Poultry Products with 75 employees
- 1960 – Plant sold to Armour and Company
- 1961 – Plant sold to Allied Mills and was named Wayne Farms
- 1963 – Plant expanded into individually frozen (IF) products
- 1982 – Plant shut down IF line, converted to whole bird chilled pack
- 1995 – Changed from chill-pack to deboning operation
- 1996 - Plant implemented MSC operation – Idled 2012
