- **1979** – Southland Broilers opens their Enterprise facility
- **1992** – Southland Broilers expanded their production to include marinated and individually frozen (IF) products
- **1994** – Continental Grain purchases the facility from Southland Foods Inc.
- **2006** – Increased production capacity to 1.25M heads/ week
- **2007** – Added a Variable Retention Freezer (VRT) including a 10M pound freezer
- **2009** – Expanded the processing facility
- **2019** – Expanded processing facility and added Controlled Atmospheric Stunning (CAS)
- **2019** – Converted to no antibiotics ever (NAE)
